AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Established in 2003, this award has evolved from honoring women veterans to honoring active duty women, to honoring all enlisted personnel who are currently serving our country in the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Coast Guard, Space Force and the National Guard/Reserve.

One enlisted servicemember from each branch of service as well as the National Guard/Reserve will be recognized at the American Legion Auxiliary National Convention. Recipients will attend the National Convention as guests of the Auxiliary.

Nomination Criteria:

- A servicemember currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces with six months or more of federal service and National Guard/Reserve with less than six months of federal service.
- A written narrative or YouTube video that demonstrates exemplary service both in and out of uniform.
- Servicemember must be willing to be a guest of the Auxiliary and speak to the general assembly of the American Legion Auxiliary National Convention.
- If self nominated, endorsement from a member of their command group must be included.
- All nomination forms must be submitted by <u>April 15, 2022</u>.

Next Steps:

- The nominating person or the servicemember writes a narrative (750 words or less) or creates a YouTube video (3 minutes or less) that shows the nominated member demonstrating exemplary service both in and out of uniform.
- The following form must be completed and submitted by <u>April 15, 2022</u>, to Department Chairman. Written narratives should be attached. YouTube video links should be pasted in the box provided on the following form.
- Endorsement from a member of their command group must be included.

If you choose to submit a video, please be sure to check that your video:

- does not contain any copyrighted music, video, images, or text (not legally owned)
- is not set to "private;" your video must be public.
- is under 2GB in size,
- is in .AVI, .MOV, .WMV, or .MPG file formats
- is 3 minutes or less in length

2021-22 INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE 2022-23 SCHOOL YEAR

The American Legion Auxiliary Department of Ohio, Past Presidents Parley, has a program to assist students pursuing a degree in the nursing field. The scholarships are available from Department Headquarters: American Legion Auxiliary, Scholarship Coordinator PO Box 2760, Zanesville, Ohio 43702-2760 or can be downloaded from the <u>www.alaohio.org</u> web site found under the Scholarship tab. Local Auxiliary Units should contact their local high schools on the availability of this scholarship.

- 1. The applicant must be an honorably discharged veteran or a spouse, son, or daughter (adopted, step, grand, or great-grand) of a living, deceased, or disabled honorably discharged veteran who served during these active war dates:
 - Due to the July 30, 2019, signing of the Let Everyone Get Involved with Opportunities for National Service – The LEGION ACT – eligibility for membership in The American Legion has been changed from the former seven war eras to two:
 - **1.** April 6, 1917 Nov. 11, 1918
 - **2.** Dec. 7, 1941 current.
- 2. Attach to this application a **photocopy** of the veteran's <u>Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active</u> <u>Duty</u> (Form DD-214) or other government document showing time served on active military duty during the eligibility period(s) indicated above.
- **3.** The applicant must be a resident of Ohio.
- 4. The applicant must be sponsored by an Ohio American Legion Auxiliary Unit.
- 5. The scholarship may be used at the nursing school of the student's choice. Proof of acceptance must be attached to application.
- 6. Accompanying the application must be three letters of recommendation from:
 - 1) A member of the clergy or a representative to attest to devotional beliefs.
 - 2) A representative of the community.
 - 3) The applicant stating his/her financial need and why he/she feels they are deserving of this scholarship.
- 7. The applicant must sign and date the application.
- 8. The completed application must be returned to the American Legion Auxiliary Unit by May 1, 2022.
- **9.** The Unit President must sign the application and forward it by <u>May 15, 2022</u>, with all supporting documents, to the Department Past Presidents Parley Chairman:
